Put your trust in Jesus as your peace offering, knowing that he satisfied God's terms of peace.

Then you will have peace with God and a relationship with him in this life and in the life to come.

Why did he do this for us?

He tells us in his Word:

For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth on him should not perish but have everlasting life.

John 3:16

He did this because he loves us.

Think about it. He offers us complete forgiveness. He offers us right standing with him.

He offers us peace.


Does this raise any questions?
